# THE FIRST TWO YEARS OF THE LANDS ACT



#### When does the Lands Act come into effect?

KDFN's Lands Act comes into effect October 15, 2020.

#### When is settlement land available?

KDFN will begin issuing land in 2021. KDFN's priority is to work with Beneficiaries and Citizens who are current occupants or have a historical submission for land. KDFN will help them apply for land based on their interests and needs.

### When can KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens apply for settlement?

KDFN is prioritizing land applications from current occupants living on settlement land and historical submissions from KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens.

## Are KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens currently living on settlement land able to apply for their parcel of land?

KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens currently living on settlement land should contact KDFN to discuss their land needs and interests and submit an application.

### How is KDFN supporting KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens in their efforts to access the land?

KDFN is working to create programs to provide financial support to offset land and develop costs for KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens.

## What happens to long-standing historical submissions for land already submitted by KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens?

KDFN has over 350 historical submissions recorded. Land applications are processed and granted to the greatest extent possible.

## Are KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens able to apply for settlement land if they don't already have an historical submission?

Yes. However, priority will be given to historical submissions and existing occupant applications.

#### How can KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens apply for a parcel of settlement land?

KDFN Beneficiaries and Citizens can apply for settlement land through a planned parcel disposition or a spot land application.

A planned parcel disposition is a lot in a planned development or a subdivision. KDFN will offer residential, recreational, commercial, industrial planned development lots through a lottery or tender process.

A spot land application is an application for a specific parcel of settlement land. The parcel is not a part of a KDFN planned development and will not be offered through a lottery or tender process.
