About the Committee

The Financial Oversight Citizen's Committee helps make sure KDFN's financial information is clear, honest, and shared with Citizens. The Committee works with the Department of Finance to:

- Review and share information about budgets, audits, and reports;
- Give advice on how to make financial information easier for Citizens to understand; and
- Support good communication between Citizens and the Department.

This is an advisory committee — it does **not** make financial decisions. Members meet at least four times each year. Honoraria are paid for approved meetings.

Who Can Be Nominated

To join the Committee, a person must:

- Be a **Kwanlin Dün First Nation Citizen**;
- Be **19 years or older**;
- Care about financial transparency and accountability;
- **Not** be an employee of the Department of Finance or a senior manager in the KDFN government; and
- **Not** be a sitting member of Council.

One member must be an **Elder**, nominated by the Elders Council.
